
WHAT IS THE RCAF?

RCAF PRIORITY POINTS & INVESTOR RANKING

HOW POINTS ARE CALCULATED

Priority points are calculated based on five criteria

1 POINT

For every \$100 given across Louisiana Athletics

1 POINT

For every \$300 given across the entire University

1 POINT

For each season ticket purchased

10 POINTS

For each year as an investor to the Champions Fund

TOTAL INVESTMENT MODEL

The RCAF rankings and benefits are based on a Total Investment Model. All gifts made to Louisiana Athletics, in the current giving year, are combined to create a Total Investment Level, which determines Investor Rankings and benefits.

HOW INVESTOR RANKING IS CALCULATED

Your Investor Rank is determined by your total yearly RCAF contributions, which establishes your Investor Level. Priority points are then used to rank you within your Investor Level.



DONOR EXAMPLE 1

Johnny Ragin gives \$750 to the Champions Fund, \$350 to the Football QB Club, \$250 to the Softball Centerfield Club, and \$200 to the Baseball Diamond Club. He's also been a long-time supporter and has accumulated 748 priority points.

Jane Cajun gives \$1,000 to the Champions Fund, \$500 to the Tennis Baseline Club, and \$400 to the Volleyball Back Reaux Club. She recently started supporting the Cajuns and has earned 220 priority points.

In this scenario, both Johnny and Jane would be in the same RCAF Giving Level. Even though Jane gave more this year, Johnny would be ranked higher than Jane because he has accumulated more priority points.

DONOR EXAMPLE 2

Johnny Ragin gives \$750 to the Champions Fund, \$350 to the Football QB Club, \$250 to the Softball Centerfield Club, and \$200 to the Baseball Diamond Club. He's also been a long-time supporter and has accumulated 748 priority points.

Jane Cajun gives \$1,000 to the Champions Fund, \$800 to the Tennis Baseline Club, \$800 to the Volleyball Back Reaux Club. She just recently started supporting the Cajuns and has earned 220 priority points.

In this scenario, Johnny remains in the \$1,000-\$2,499 RCAF Giving Level while Jane is placed in the \$2,500-\$4,999 RCAF Giving Level. Because Jane has increased her RCAF Membership level, she would now be ranked higher than Johnny even though he has more priority points than her.



2026-27 LOUISIANA ATHLETICS PRIORITY SEATING

HOW TO RETAIN, ADD, OR RELOCATE FOOTBALL SEASON TICKETS, PARKING & TAILGATING?

RETAIN OR RELOCATE FOOTBALL SEASON TICKETS

The 2026 Football Priority Seating deadline is on April 30, 2026. Fans must renew their football season tickets and required RCAF Champions Fund Fees by the deadline to retain their same seat locations from the 2025 season. Following the April 30 deadline, fans that renewed their tickets and required Champions Fund Fees on time, can go through an upgrade and relocation process similar to seat selection in 2025. The upgrade and relocation process will begin in May (refer to Page 12).

RETAIN OR RELOCATE FOOTBALL PARKING AND TAILGATING

Fans must renew their parking and/or tailgating locations before the Priority Seating Deadline on April 30, 2026. All Champions Fund contributions and pass payments are due by the Priority Seating Deadline. Fans can upgrade or relocate their parking or tailgating during the upgrade and relocation process in May. Any additional Champions Fund contributions or pass payments are due at checkout.

NEW FOOTBALL SEASON TICKET HOLDERS


Join the RCAF by April 30, 2026. New season ticket holders will be ranked based on the RCAF Total Investment Model Ranking for the 2026-27 RCAF Membership Year and will receive a timeslot to select a season ticket location. Upon selection, fans will be directed to add parking and tailgating for the 2026 season.

FOOTBALL SEASON TICKET PROCESS

Group 1: 2025 Football Season Ticket Holders who renew by the Priority Seating Deadline on April 30, 2026.

Group 2: 2026-27 RCAF Members who didn't have 2025 Football Season Tickets.

Group 3: Football Season Ticket Holders who didn't renew by the Priority Seating Deadline on April 30, 2026. For this group, the 2025 season tickets will be dropped from their account if tickets and required Champions Fund Fees are not renewed by April 30, 2026.

RETAIN OR RELOCATE SEASON TICKETS

Men's Basketball Priority Seating Deadline: August 30, 2026

Baseball and Softball Priority Seating Deadline: October 30, 2026

Fans must renew their season tickets and required RCAF Champions Fund Fees by the deadlines to retain their same seat locations from the previous season. Before the Priority Seating Deadlines, fans can request a relocation on their online season ticket renewal application. Following the Priority Seating Deadlines, Louisiana Athletics Ticket Office will contact all accounts with a relocation request based on the RCAF Total Investment Model Ranking for the 2026-27 RCAF Membership Year.

RETAIN OR RELOCATE MEN'S BASKETBALL OR SOFTBALL PARKING

Fans must renew their parking location before the Priority Seating Deadlines. All Champions Fund contributions and pass payments are due by the Priority Seating Deadlines. Fans can upgrade or relocate their parking by adding a request on their online season ticket renewal application.


NEW SEASON TICKET HOLDERS

Fans wanting new season tickets before the Priority Seating Deadlines will only pay for the price of the ticket. Champions Fund Fees are not due at the time of purchase. Following the deadline, the Louisiana Athletics Ticket Office will contact fans to select a seating location. Once a seating location has been selected, all required Champions Fund Fees are due at this time.

The 2026 Football Priority Seating deadline is on April 30, 2026. Fans must renew their football season tickets and required RCAF Champions Fund Fees by the seating deadline to retain their same seat locations from the 2025 season. Following the April 30 deadline, fans that renewed their tickets and required Champions Fund Fees on time, can go through an upgrade and relocation process similar to seat selection in 2025. The upgrade and relocation process will begin in May and will be based on the RCAF Total Investment Model Ranking for the 2026-27 RCAF Membership Year.

METHODS OF GIVING

PAYMENT PLANS

RCAF Members can meet their desired investor level by setting up a payment plan. These payment plans can be set up by calling the RCAF office or online through Account Manager.

MAIL

Gifts can be made to the RCAF by mailing in your renewal form along with your payment information, either check or credit card. If paying by check, make payable to "RCAF".

MATCHING GIFTS

Some employers match charitable contributions made by their employees. Please check with your employer and submit your matching claim with your gift.

PAYROLL DEDUCTION

University of Louisiana employees are eligible to give to the RCAF through a payroll deduction payment plan. Payroll deductions can be setup through employees' ULink accounts.

GIFTS OF SECURITIES

Stocks, bonds, mutual funds, etc. are accepted and appreciated by the RCAF. These gifts typically involve publicly traded shares, such as those traded on the major exchanges and over the counter, as well as most mutual funds. Gifts of privately held stock, though more complex, are also possible.

PLANNED OR ESTATE GIFTS

Gifts in the form of life income gifts (Charitable Remainder Trust, Charitable Gift Annuity), charitable lead trusts, and/or bequests are common ways to state your intentions of leaving a future gift to Louisiana Athletics while receiving substantial income, estate, and gift tax benefits now.

OTHER WAYS TO GIVE
